 Read the passage given below and answer the questions that follow:

The daily explosion of crime, violence and sex on the small screen reaches approximately onethird of the country's population.

Fifty years ago there was only one channel, Doordarshan. Now there are more than 50 channels. TV is no longer just a means for informing news, disseminating information and building opinion. It is also for providing entertainment. The unfortunate development is that it has increasingly become the instrument for projecting crime, thrillers, horrors, vulgarity, obscenity. Scenes of sex, crime and violence capture the imagination of large sections of viewers, expecially children. And these create a disturbing impact on them.

Specialists have identified as many as 60 types of violence projected on TV, both audio and visual. These include slapping, threats, screaming, shooting, assaulting, abusing, pushing, stabbing, mental torture, eerie sound

tracks and threatening music. Most of the violence is explicit and graphic and noticeably lengthy.

Children admire superheroes such as Shaktiman who is capable of extraordinary physical feats; they tend to imbibe the exploits of such superheroes. Family drama serials also often depict conflicts which involve violence. These carry scenes of domestic violence, often involving children. There is an obvious tendency to glorify violence.

These circumstances need to be urgently considered by governmental authorities as well as social activists so that measures can be devised and adopted for mitigating the situation. These include persuading channels to adopt self-regulating measures. They should

also be forced to fix time, not earlier than 10 P. M., in which serials and programmes containing scenes of sex and violence can be telecast. They should avoid repeating these shows at an earlier time, and also put across a written or verbal warning before such a programme begins. Child specific programmes should be developed and telecast by all channels.
